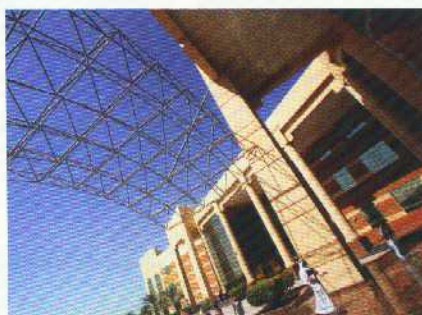


AUST chooses Avaya LAN
